 - 2.1. Scope

3. Source Selection and Contract Award

Award(s), if made, will be made to the Responsive and Responsible proposer(s) whose proposal is most advantageous to SCS, taking into consideration price and the other evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP.

- o General Criteria to be determined "Responsive"
 - f Does the proposal include all required information, included completed attachment forms and affidavits?
 - f Was the proposal delivered on or before the stated deadline? Did it include the required number of copies (hard & electronic)?
- General Criteria to be determined "Responsible"
 - f Does the Proposer demonstrate an understanding of SCSs needs and proposed approach to the project?
 - f Does the Proposer possess the ability, capacity, skill and financial resources to provide the service?
 - f Can the Proposer take upon itself the responsibilities set forth in the RFP and produce the required outcomes in a timely fashion?

Prime contractor bidders who are to perform the masonry portion of the construction project which exceeds one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), materials and labor, the electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation or air conditioning or the geothermal heating and cooling must be so designated; and
- 6. Only one (1) contractor in each of the classifications listed above shall be written on the bid envelope.

Failure of any bidder to furnish the required information shall void such bid and such bid shall not be considered.

5.6. Delivery of Proposals

Sealed proposals will be accepted until <u>January 10, 2023 @ 11:00 am Local Time</u> Proposals received after that time will be deemed invalid. Vendors mailing proposal packages must allow sufficient time to ensure receipt of their package by the time specified. SCS shall not accept proposals via electronic transmission such as email, fax, etc. There will be no exceptions. Proposals will be opened and read aloud. The reading of the bids will begin at 11:00 am Local Time.
