

 - 2x4 Stud Wall attached to existing concrete pad with pressure treated mudsills.
 - #1 Metal, 16-gauge exterior wall. Dark Gray in color.
 - #1 Metal, 16-gauge roof. Black in color.
 - Roof framing to be truss design with gable to receive metal roof panels.
 - Exterior soffits to be vinyl. Owner will accept metal soffit, as long as it is vented.
 - Gutters are required.
 - Single, Right Hand, Metal Entry Door. White in color
 - Double, Metal Entry Door. White in color.
 - Standard size single residential style garage door. Non-insulated. No glass panels. Manual operation. White in color.

Does the Proposer have the character, integrity, reputation, judgement, experience and efficiency required for the project?

5. Instructions for Proposal

- 5.1. Required Forms
 - Proposer must complete and submit the Attachments in Section 6. Attachments may be omitted depending on the RFP requirements. Refer to the Table of Contents for omitted Attachments.
 - Evidence of a valid State of Tennessee Business License and/or Sumner County Business License.
 - For all vendors with annual purchases in excess of \$50,000; a Sumner County Business License must be on file with the SCS Finance Department. Evidence of the license must be provided within ten (10) working days following notification of award; otherwise, SCS may rescind its acceptance of the Proposer's proposal.
 - Copy of State of Tennessee License (if applicable) in respective field.
 - If applicable, the Proposer must include a copy of the contract(s) the Proposer will submit to be signed.
- 5.2. New Vendors
 - To comply with Internal Revenue Service requirements, all vendors who perform any type of service are required to have a current IRS Form W-9 on file with the SCS Finance Department. It is a mandatory requirement to complete the IRS Form W-9 (Attachment 6.9) included in this RFP.
 - To comply with the Tennessee Lawful Employment Act (50-1-702 and 50-1-703), non-employees (individuals paid directly by the employer in exchange for the individual's labor or services) must have on file one (1) of the following documents:

A valid Tennessee driver's license or photo identification;

A valid driver's license or photo identification from another state where the license requirements are at least as strict as those in Tennessee;

A birth certificate issued by a U.S. state, jurisdiction or territory;

A U.S. government issued certified birth certificate;

A valid, unexpired U.S. passport;

A U.S. certificate of birth abroad (DS-1350 or FS-545)

A report of birth abroad of a U.S. citizen (FS-240);

A certificate of citizenship (N560 or N561);

A certificate of naturalization (N550, N570 or N578);

A U.S citizen identification card (I-197 or I-179); or

Valid alien registration documentation or other proof of current immigration registration recognized by the United States Department of Homeland Security that contains the individual's complete legal

5.3. Acknowledgement of Insurance Requirements

By submitting a proposal, Proposer acknowledges that it has read and understands the insurance requirements for the proposal. The Proposer who may have employees, contractors, subcontractors or agents working on SCS properties shall carry current certificates for general and professional liability insurance and for workers' compensation as indicated below. The owner or Principal of each Proposer must also be insured by workers' compensation if they perform any of the services on SCS properti

The outside of the proposal package must be labeled as follows (if applicable):

- 1. Name of Company and Principal Owner, Business License Number, Expiration Date and License Classification.
- 2. In addition to Item 1, the same is applicable to masonry contractors if the work performed is > \$100,000.
- 3. In addition to Item 1, the same is applicable to HVAC, electrical, plumbing or A/C contractors if the work performed is > \$25,000.
- In addition to Item 1, the same is applicable plus the Department of Environment & Conservation License Number and Classification, applicable to geothermal contractors if the work performed is > \$25,000.
- 5. If the prime contractor performs the masonry portion of the project or any of the above listed contractor skill sets and the work performed is > \$100,000; it must be so designated.
- 6. Only one (1) contractor in each classification listed shall be written on the bid envelope.
- 5.6. Delivery of Proposals

Sealed proposals will be accepted until <u>April 9, 2019 @ 1:30 p.m. Local Time</u>. Proposals received after that time will be deemed invalid. Vendors mailing proposal packages must allow sufficient time to ensure receipt of their package by the time specified. There will be no exceptions. Proposals will be opened and read aloud. The reading of the bids will begin at <u>1:30 p.m. Local Time</u>.


